Q&A session

- Questions about disaggregating demographic data and not lumping together
- Including student voice – what is their input
 - The 2019-24 Strategic Plan
 - SpEd and IEPs
 - Sexual Education (e.g. FLASH) & gender identity
 - Culturally responsiveness for teachers (e.g. Ethnic Studies)
- The ask from (all) community groups for data – what’s the data plan for the work groups (e.g. 3rd grade meeting)
- Targeted universalism
- Addressing the whiteness of the candidates running for the open school board positions
- Strategic Plan is the guiding light for the next 5 years

Reflections on Superintendent’s visit

- Like including pre-K in the “3rd” grade reading target
- Asked the Board to hold her accountable
- Ask questions of the candidates

School Board elections – how can ERAC influence?

- ? simple language to “translate” the 0030 report
- ERAC forum to “meet the candidates”?

ERAC recruitment

- Ask members who have left why they left
- Have clear focus of what ERAC is doing; plan = interest
- Re-activate former members
- Make it more engaging for the student voice
- Provide childcare for parents with younger children
- Provide ORCA cards so students can get here
- What is the mission/vision/belief & values of ERAC? Define those
- Have something to share when ERAC comes to the table – sub-committee groups
- Smaller foci
- No common message
- Access to the school district; issue presentation (usually one-off)
- Information deprivatization of the impact of ERAC work
